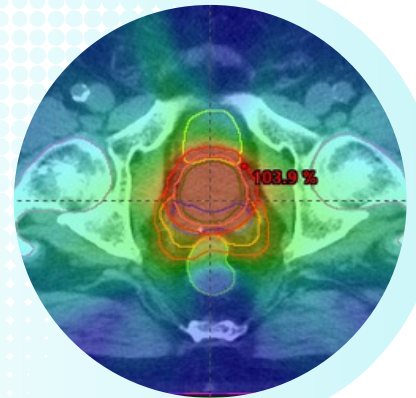




What is Radiotherapy?

What is a Clinical Audit?

A clinical audit is a systematic evaluation of healthcare services to ensure they meet established quality standards. The aim of a clinical audit is to **identify areas for improvement and ensure that patients receive the best possible care**. It is not an inspection but an opportunity to learn and enhance practices.





How Will CAT-ClinART Benefit Patients?

The **CAT-ClinART** project aims to improve the quality and safety of radiotherapy in Catalonia through the implementation of a clinical audit system. This means:

- Healthcare professionals will receive specialised training in clinical audits, helping them **identify and implement best practices**.
- **Standardised guidelines and tools for conducting clinical audits will be developed**, ensuring consistency and reliability of results.
- **Best practices in radiotherapy will be identified and implemented**, enabling patients to benefit from the latest advancements.
- **Patients' voices will be considered**, as a patient representative will be part of the project's advisory board.
